We remain resolved and dedicated to opening the physical buildings of Bristol International College in August 2021, once the situation has stabilized, but for those students who would like to start their university studies in Autumn 2021 the Online IFP is the ideal solution for bridging that gap and not wasting a whole year! 

BIC Online - Summary

- Bristol International College (BIC) is a University of London Recognised Teaching Centre approved to teach the International Foundation Programme (IFP)
- BIC Online will offer a virtual IFP starting in August 2020: specially designed online platform; structured timetable to cover all Time Zones; all lessons recorded and downloadable; highly-qualified and experienced online tutors
- 8-month intensive academic study programme for students aged 16-18 who wish to access leading UK and international universities

BIC Online – Introductory Questions & Answers

- Which online platform will BIC be using? Is there a backup platform in case of errors?
 - BIC will be using its own bespoke platform called "Workbit". The backup platforms will be Microsoft Teams and Google Classroom.
- Will I be able to access the course from anywhere in the world?

Yes, if your English is sufficient and you pass our entry requirements. Bristol International College will provide you with an 8-month teaching programme (September – May) which will give you access to every lecture and recorded tutorial that is delivered throughout the year. The Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) provided by the University of London will also give you 24/7 access all year round.

- How will the time differences work? You may work within your own time-zone, as all material and teaching instruction will be recorded online.
- How does an online classroom work?
 The work is presented in a "lecture" style fashion by a fully qualified and experienced expert in his or her field.
 There will be question and answer sessions throughout each lecture.
- Will I be trained regarding online classrooms and VLEs (Virtual Learning Environments)? Yes, there will be a full induction week during the week of 24th August where a number of tutorials, seminars and lectures will be given so that you are fully confident in how the system works before term starts on Monday 31st August.



 How will my online contact with teachers work? How will it be monitored/assessed?

You will receive regular weekly small group tutorial work (setup within your specific time zone, where possible). You will also be allocated a private one-on-one session with your tutor at least once a month. Regular email/chat contact is also encouraged.

How will my attendance be monitored?
 Is there a minimum number of classes to attend?

A register will be taken for each lecture and tutorial and this information will be communicated to your parents. The College has its own attendance policy with coordinated sanctions for absence. It is expected that you attend all the lectures each week.

What happens if I miss a lecture/class?

You will be able to catch up on what you have missed through the recorded lectures and relevant course materials which are both available on the virtual learning platform.

 How will the College ensure that I am making the most of the opportunities on offer?

Each student will be assigned an academic and pastoral tutor whose role will be to ensure that their students are taking advantage of all that is on offer (visiting speakers, online activities and virtual cultural trips to important cities). This information will be communicated to students and parents on a regular basis.

 How will I be assessed (continual and final assessment)

There will be regular assessments throughout the year, all of which culminate in the University of London final examinations at the end of April.

 Will I still be able to engage in cultural activities as if I were in the UK?

BIC will guide students towards online events that are free of charge and will provide students with a cultural insight into life in the UK. There is also a plethora of online events streamed from London to all over the world. For example, the National Theatre is streaming a different play live every Thursday evening and most museums undertake virtual online tours around their artefacts.

 Will I be able to make friends and build on relationships even though we are all in different countries?

During the first week of orientation there will be various tasks set between students of different nationalities, some social and some academic. You will become very well acquainted with each other very quickly! There is the opportunity to connect with others within the course and online to collaborate and/or develop friendships.

 How will my parents be able to pay BIC for my IFP online course?

Bristol International College has partnered with Flywire, which offers an easy-to-use payment solution, providing international payers with a streamlined payment experience which saves institutions and their payers time and money. Making an international payment easier, faster, more transparent and cost effective for payers. All payments are linked to the individual student and can be fully tracked.



 Do I need to have my own learning equipment (textbooks, computers, headphones etc)?

Yes, you will be provided with a reading list and you will need your own dedicated equipment. Our IT team will be able to advise you on exactly what you need.

Will there be a dedicated tutor in charge of safeguarding and on-line safety (including anti-bullying)?

Yes, we take the safety of our students extremely seriously and there is a dedicated member of staff responsible for all areas of pastoral care, health and wellbeing.

Entry requirements

Minimum age requirement

All applicants must be at least 16 years old in order to be considered for a place on the course but must also turn 17 before 31.12.2020

Submission of satisfactory recent school reports and any examination results

We need to have a good understanding of your educational background, to know what qualifications you already have and to read what your teachers and tutors have said about you, both academically and as a member of a school community. We are looking for evidence of effort, achievement and good behaviour.

Successful completion of our online Admissions Tests

These tests primarily examine your numeracy and literacy skills and you must achieve a minimum level that indicates that you will be able to succeed on your chosen course with us.

Successful interview by Skype or WeChat

The purpose of the interview is to allow us to find out what kind of person you are and where your strengths and interests lie. It is important that both you and we are confident that BIC Online is the right place for the next stage of your education. The interview is also an opportunity for you to ask questions about the courses and the online tuition.

English language proficiency (overseas students)

We must be satisfied that an overseas student has the required level of English language skills for academic studies on the University of London International Foundation Programme. If you have not already taken an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test or similar, you must sit an equivalent diagnostic test. To be accepted on the IFP course you must have a minimum level of IELTS 6.0 or an equivalent recognised qualification at CEFR Level B2 minimum.

Prompt payment of fees due

It is important that the Course Fees due are paid by the stated deadlines, otherwise BIC will not be able to allow you to start your course.





Application & Admission Process

Applying to join the University of London International Foundation Programme (IFP) online at Bristol International College is straightforward and easy. Simply follow the steps below and don't hesitate to ask us if you need any help.

Step 1: Enquiry

 If you have any questions please use our online Enquiry Form on the website or alternatively, if you have already received information on the programme and wish to register your son or daughter, please go directly to Step 2.

Step 2: Registration

- · Register online on the website
- Please complete and return the Registration Form.
- Please attach or send a copy of the student's most recent school report (translated into English if applicable), a copy of the photograph page from his or her passport and (for international students) proof of his or her English Language level.
- Please arrange a BACS payment of the £120.00 Registration Fee.

Step 3: Admissions Tests

 On receipt of the Registration Form and Fee you will be asked to complete our online Admissions Tests in Mathematics, English and General Knowledge. These assessment tests must be invigilated by an approved third party and can be completed in your home country or at your current school.

Step 4: Interview

 Applicants who reach the required standard in the Admissions Tests will be invited to an interview via Skype or WeChat.

Step 5: Offer of a Place

 Successful candidates will receive an Offer of a place on the Online Course at which time we will ask you to complete and return an Acceptance Form, along with the Course Fees due (see Payment Schedule on Course Fees page) within 14 days of the offer.

Step 6: Acceptance of a Place

 On receipt of the Course Fees and signed Acceptance Form, your child's place is secured on the Online Course.

Step 7: Joining Instructions

 Once your place is confirmed we will send you all the information you need regarding joining Bristol International College Online, including access to our Virtual Learning Platform (VLP), term dates, information booklet, timetables etc.
