St Edward's School is a co-educational day and boarding school, 15 minutes from the centre of Oxford. Surrounded by over 90 acres of playing fields, the school offers an interesting mix of historic and modern architecture.

Founded in 1863, the school offers a wonderful suite of facilities for Bucksmore's programmes including a music centre and recording studio, modern classrooms, a collegiate style reading room and a 1,000 seater hall. This, paired with a range of sports facilities makes St Edward's one of Bucksmore's most prestigious boarding school venues.

Accommodation:

Bucksmore bedrooms are located on the school campus in Apsley boarding house. The bedrooms are single, twin and a small number of triple rooms with shared bathrooms between 4-6 students.

Male and female accommodation is in separate corridors with staff members present along each corridor.



Transfers:

Bucksmore offers a free airport transfer service for all students at St Edward's arriving and/or departing between 10:00-20:00 at:

- London Heathrow (LHR)
- London Gatwick (LGW)

Students requesting private transfers outside of these destinations and times will be subject to additional charges.

Laundry:

Did you know?

In the Second World War, air raid shelters were dug into the grass of the Quad. The school was presented with a stained glass window by the RAF at the end of the war in recognition of "the superb contribution to the war effort made by former pupils of the School".



Common Spaces

The boarding house has a large, spacious common room for students to spend their time in between periods and at the end of their day. It contains sofas, a television and table tennis set.
